Truth never made error necessary, nor devised a law to perpetuate error.

8 | 63:12, 23

Civil law establishes very unfair differences

The rights of woman between the rights of the two sexes. Christian Science furnishes no precedent for such injustice, and civilization mitigates it in some measure. Still, it is a marvel why usage should accord woman less rights than does either Christian Science or civilization.

A feasible as well as rational means of improvement at present is the elevation of society in general and the achievement of a nobler race for legislation, — a race having higher aims and motives.

9 | 226:14

God has built a higher platform of human
rights, and He has built it on diviner claims. These
claims are not made through code or creed, but in demonstration of "on earth peace, good-will toward men." Human codes, scholastic theology, material medicine and hygiene, fetter faith and spiritual understanding. Divine Science rends asunder these fetters, and man's birthright of sole allegiance to his
Maker asserts itself.

10 | 340:23

One infinite God, good, unifies men and nations; constitutes the brotherhood of man; ends wars; fulfils the Scripture, "Love thy neighbor as thyself;" annihilates pagan and Christian idolatry, — whatever is wrong in social, civil, criminal, political, and religious codes; equalizes the sexes; annuls the curse on man, and leaves nothing that can sin, suffer, be punished or destroyed.

11 | 515:21 Man

Man is the family name for all ideas, — the sons and daughters of God. All that God imparts moves in accord with Him, reflecting goodness and power.

10 | Psalms 103:6, 7

6 The Lord executeth righteousness and judgment for all that are oppressed. 7 He made known his ways unto Moses, his acts unto the children of Israel.

11 | John 1:17

17 For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ.

12 | Luke 13:11-17

11 And, behold, there was a woman which had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up herself. 12 And when Jesus saw her, he called her to him, and said unto her, Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity. 13 And he laid his hands on her: and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God. 14 And the ruler of the synagogue answered with indignation, because that Jesus had healed on the sabbath day, and said unto the people, There are six days in which men ought to work: in them therefore come and be healed, and not on the sabbath day. 15 The Lord then answered him, and said, Thou hypocrite, doth not each one of you on the sabbath loose his ox or his ass from the stall, and lead him away to watering? 16 And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day? 17 And when he had said these things, all his adversaries were ashamed: and all the people rejoiced for all the glorious things that were done by him.

13 | II John 1:3

3 Grace be with you, mercy, and peace, from God the Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love.

12 | 67:23

Grace and Truth are potent beyond all other means and methods.

13 | 473:10-15

Christ is the ideal Truth, that comes to heal sickness and sin through Christian Science, and attributes all power to God. Jesus is the name of the man who, more than all other men, has presented Christ, the true idea of God, healing the sick and the sinning and destroying the power of death.

14 | 38:24-26, 30

Jesus mapped out the path for others. He unveiled the Christ, the spiritual idea of divine Love.

He taught that the material senses shut out Truth and its healing power.

15 | 390:12

When the first symptoms of disease appear, Unnecessary dispute the testimony of the material senses with divine Science. Let your higher sense of justice destroy the false process of mortal opinions which you name law, and then you will not be confined to a sick-room nor laid upon a bed of suffering in payment of the last farthing, the last penalty demanded by error. "Agree with thine adversary quickly, whiles thou art in the way with him." Suffer no claim of sin or of sick-

ness to grow upon the thought. Dismiss it with an abiding conviction that it is illegitimate, because you know that God is no more the author of sickness than He is of sin. You have no law of His to support the necessity either of sin or sickness, but you have divine authority for denying that necessity and healing the sick.

16 | 391:17-19, 24

Justice is the moral signification of law. Injustice declares the absence of law. When the body is supposed to say, "I am sick," never plead guilty.

Disease has no intelligence to declare itself something and announce its name. Mortal mind alone sentences itself. Therefore make your own terms with sickness, and be just to yourself and to others.

17 | 418:22

By the truthful arguments you employ, and especially by the spirit of Truth and Love which you entertain, you will heal the sick.

14 | Isaiah 56:1

1 Thus saith the Lord, Keep ye judgment, and do justice: for my salvation is near to come, and my righteousness to be revealed.

15 | Proverbs 14:22

22 Do they not err that devise evil? but mercy and truth shall be to them that devise good.

16 | Ecclesiastes 5:8

8 If thou seest the oppression of the poor, and violent perverting of judgment and justice in a province, marvel not at the matter: for he that is higher than the highest regardeth; and there be higher than they.

17 | Isaiah 33:10 (to 2nd ;), 13, 15, 16 (to 1st :), 22

- 10 Now will I rise, saith the Lord; now will I be exalted;
- 13 Hear, ye that are far off, what I have done; and, ye that are near, acknowledge my might.
- 15 He that walketh righteously, and speaketh uprightly; he that despiseth the gain of oppressions, that shaketh his hands from holding of bribes, that stoppeth his ears from hearing of blood, and shutteth his eyes from seeing evil; 16 He shall dwell on high:

22 For the Lord is our judge, the Lord is our lawgiver, the Lord is our king; he will save us.

18 | Isaiah 9:6 (to 2nd :), 7

- 6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder:
- 7 Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this.

God has endowed man with inalienable
rights, among which are self-government, reason, and conscience. Man is properly self-governed only when he is guided rightly and governed by his Maker, divine Truth and Love.

19 | 239:12-13

Let it be understood that success in error is defeat in Truth.

20 | 542:5-8, 10, 19-21

Though error hides behind a lie and excuses guilt, error cannot forever be concealed. Truth, through her eternal laws, unveils error.

The avoidance of justice and the denial of truth tend to perpetuate sin, invoke crime, jeopardize self-control, and mock divine mercy.

Let Truth uncover and destroy error in

God's own way, and let human justice pattern

the divine.

Retribution and remorse

21 | 223:28-32

Marvels, calamities, and sin will much more abound as truth urges upon mortals its resisted claims; but the awful daring of sin destroys sin, and foreshadows the triumph of truth. God will overturn, until "He come whose right it is."

22 | 565:13-18

The impersonation of the spiritual idea had a brief history in the earthly life of our Master; but "of his kingdom there shall be no end," for Christ, God's idea, will eventually rule all nations and peoples — imperatively, absolutely, finally — with divine Science.

The Bible

19 | John 8:31, 32

Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed;

And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

20 | John 5:1 there, 5, 8, 9 (to:)

- 1 there was a feast of the Jews; and Jesus went up to Jerusalem.
- 5 And a certain man was there, which had an infirmity thirty and eight years.
 - 8 Jesus saith unto him, Rise, take up thy bed, and walk.
- 9 And immediately the man was made whole, and took up his bed, and walked:

21 | Psalms 119:33, 45

- 33 Teach me, O Lord, the way of thy statutes; and I shall keep it unto the end.
 - 45 And I will walk at liberty: for I seek thy precepts.

23 | 227:21-26

Christian Science raises the standard of liberty
and cries: "Follow me! Escape from the bondage of
sickness, sin, and death!" Jesus marked out the way. Citizens
of the world, accept the "glorious liberty of the children of
God," and be free! This is your divine right.

24 | 381:2-4, 15-16, 28

Ignorant of our God-given rights, we submit to unjust decrees, and the bias of education enforces this slavery.

God is the lawmaker, but He is not the author of barbarous codes.

It is man's moral right to annul an unjust sentence, a sentence never inflicted by divine authority.

25 | 183:26-29

Truth casts out all evils and materialistic methods with the actual spiritual law, — the law which gives sight to the blind, hearing to the deaf, voice to the dumb, feet to the lame.

26 | 390:32

Rise in the conscious strength of the spirit of Truth to overthrow the plea of mortal mind, *alias* matter, arrayed against the supremacy of Spirit. Blot out the images of mortal thought and its beliefs in sickness and sin. Then, when thou

art delivered to the judgment of Truth, Christ, the judge will say, "Thou art whole!"

22 | II Thessalonians 3:1

1 Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be glorified, even as it is with you:

23 | II Corinthians 13:8

8 For we can do nothing against the truth, but for the truth.

24 | Acts 5:12 (to ;), 16-21, 25, 27 (to :), 34, 35, 38-40 (to :)

- 12 And by the hands of the apostles were many signs and wonders wrought among the people;
- about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed every one. 17 Then the high priest rose up, and all they that were with him, (which is the sect of the Sadducees,) and were filled with indignation, 18 And laid their hands on the apostles, and put them in the common prison. 19 But the angel of the Lord by night opened the prison doors, and brought them

forth, and said, 20 Go, stand and speak in the temple to the people all the words of this life. 21 And when they heard that, they entered into the temple early in the morning, and taught. But the high priest came, and they that were with him, and called the council together, and all the senate of the children of Israel, and sent to the prison to have them brought.

- 25 Then came one and told them, saying, Behold, the men whom ye put in prison are standing in the temple, and teaching the people.
- 27 And when they had brought them, they set them before the council:
- Then stood there up one in the council, a Pharisee named Gamaliel, a doctor of the law, had in reputation among all the people, and commanded to put the apostles forth a little space; 35 And said unto them, Ye men of Israel, take heed to yourselves what ye intend to do as touching these men.
- 38 And now I say unto you, Refrain from these men, and let them alone: for if this counsel or this work be of men, it will come to nought: 39 But if it be of God, ye cannot overthrow it; lest haply ye be found even to fight against God.

7 who did hinder you that ye should not obey the truth?

13 For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty;

27 | 227:14-15, 17-19 *All*

Discerning the rights of man, we cannot fail to foresee the doom of all oppression.

All men should be free. "Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty."

28 | 97:22, 32

It requires courage to utter truth; for the higher Truth lifts her voice, the louder will error scream, until its inarticulate sound is forever silenced in oblivion.

Earth has no repayment for the persecutions which attend a new step in Christianity; but the spiritual recompense of the persecuted is assured in the elevation of existence above mortal discord and in the gift of divine Love.

29 | 224:22-25

A higher and more practical Christianity, demonstrating justice and meeting the needs of mortals in sickness and in health, stands at the door of this age, knocking for admission.

30 | 326:20

Working and praying with true motives, your Father will open the way. "Who did hinder you, that ye should not obey the truth?"

31 | 225:3

Truth makes man free.
